**29 March 2020** Deadline for practices to participate: has been offered out to all GP practices, please log into CQRS and accept this service. **QOF 2020/21**

**To note:** If practices do not participate by the deadline:

- standard aspiration payments for QOF 2020/21 will not be calculated for the GP practice and an interim calculation will be run instead
- the practice may not receive a QOF aspiration payment in April 2020.
